Check Your Registration or Register for the First Time



- Don't allow uncertainty to keep you from the polls! Verify your registration or complete the process now at www.millionvoices.org

Identify Your Polling Station



- Your residential address determines your specific polling spot. Remember, you can't just walk into any polling location to cast your vote. So, make sure you're aware of your designated location. You can typically look this up on your state's Secretary of State or your county voting websites.

Evaluate Your Ballot from a Biblical Perspective

- Your ballot might contain unfamiliar names and issues. But don't let this deter you! Do your research. Does the candidate uphold Christian values? Are they pro-life? Do they believe in traditional marriage? If an incumbent, how have they voted in the past? (For future – offer access to voter guides to become an informed voter.)



Know Your State's Voter ID Laws



- Each state has distinct ID requirements. Ensure you're carrying the right identification like a driver's license or another valid ID, so there's no last-minute hurdle to cast your vote.

- Ask for divine guidance as you make your voting decisions to bring justice, righteousness, truth, and peace back to America.
